To celebrate 20-years of NCMRWF and 50-years of NWP in India, the Centre is organizing an International Conference.

Broad-topics that shall be covered in the Conference are

- (i) Global Modeling/Data Assimilation/Medium Range Prediction Systems
- (ii) Meso-scale/Regional Modeling/high Impact Weather Prediction
- (iii) Climate and Climate Change Modeling
- (iv) Monsoon Simulation/Modeling and Predictability
- (v) Observation Systems/Field Campaigns
- (vi) Numerical Model Product Interpretation and Applications

All the oral presentations at the Conference will be in the form of invited talks by leading experts. Several world renowned scientists from USA, UK, Japan, Australia and India have confirmed their participation in the Conference. Experts from some other countries have also been invited.

Authors of the selected abstracts will be intimated by e-mail regarding the details of the poster size, extended abstract etc. Selected participants from India shall be provided local hospitality and train fare (to and fro, limited to AC 2-Tier). Registration for the Conference is free.
